**HOW TO PLAY**

Shuffle the cards and deal them out equally among the players. Each player holds their cards face up, so that they can only see the card on top. The youngest player starts the game by choosing a category from their top card and reading out the number (e.g. Driver Skill 7). The other players then read out their numbers for the same category. The player with the highest number wins that round and that player collects all the losing cards and places them, along with their own winning card, at the bottom of their pile. The winning player then chooses the category for the next round. If two or more cards have the same winning value, then all the cards for that round are put in the middle and the same player chooses again from the next card. The winner of this round takes all the cards from the middle as well. The winner is the person who has all cards at the end of the game.
